\* Produce that has *kedushat sheviit* will always have that kedusha even after the date on the table has passed. For example, once a fruit with *Kedushat Shviit* is purchased, that specific fruit will have kedusha. These tables are only to determine if new fruit that you are buying has Kedusha.

\* Canned or preserved products can have *kedushat sheviit* for long after the dates listed on this table.

\* If the produce you purchase has a *teuda* that is different than the chart below, you must rely on the *teuda*. The following charts are for cases when there is no *teuda*.

## NOTES

- (1) Much of this product is imported from *chutz laaretz*.
- (2) All of this product is imported from *chutz laaretz* and therefore has no Kedushat Shviit.
- (3) Most of this product is imported from *chutz laaretz*.
- (4) Some of this product is produced by non-Jews
- (5) There are two types of cherries and they are often confused: the cherry that is most commonly found in our stores is really a “גודגודן” (Prunus avium=sweet cherry) but is commonly called “דובדובן”. The real “דובדובן” (Prunus creasus=sour cherry) is really only used in food manufacturing. For this table we use the former.
- (6) This product exists in the field all year round and therefore has no obligation of biyur.
- (7) Much of this product is grown hydroponically and does not have Kedushat Shviit
