#### **APPLICATION FORMS**

### FEES (ALL INCLUSIVE)

Tuition and maintenance fees for the 5766-2005/06 academic year total \$14,500 (U.S.) and cover ●tuition ●dormitory ●3 meals a day ●medical care ●hospitalization insurance ●laundry service ●e mail ●visa renewal (passport to be submitted upon request), and ●field trips. In addition, there is a \$500 Building Fund fee, \$250 of which is tax-deductible. This \$500 fee is to be sent with the first payment, in a separate check, as indicated below. This fee entitles parents to two reservations to the Sha'alvim National Dinner or any one of the regional fund raising events. These fees will not be refunded if a student leaves the Yeshiva before the end of the academic year. Fees and/or scholarships received from universities, or other sources in excess of \$14,500, will be refunded. A tax-deductible receipt in the amount of \$250 will be mailed to you.

Fees may be paid to the Yeshiva in full or in 4 installments with a current check of \$4000 (US) plus the \$500 (US) Building Fund fee check, and three payments each of \$3500 (US) on September 1, December 1, and February 1, or through Yeshiva University. [see e) below].

- e) Enrollees through Y.U. send Yeshivat Sha'alvim a first payment of \$3500, plus the \$500 (US) Building Fund fee check, together with the confirmation and pay the balance of \$11,000 through Y.U.

Parents and students are to sign the enclosed **CONFIRMATION** and mail it together with appropriate payments as soon as possible, to arrive at our New York, Canadian or Israel office by April 20. (The first payment may be divided into 2 checks, with the second one postdated for May 15. The \$500 Building Fund check should arrive with first half of current payment.) Acceptances will be valid only upon receipt and approval of application, medical form, transcripts, references, signed confirmation and timely payment of all appropriate fees.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL ATTENTION AND HOSPITALIZATION INSURANCE: Every student will receive above. However, it is important to maintain your own coverage as our hospitalization policy does not cover recurring or aggravated illness. *Dental, optical, physiotherapy, psychological, psychiatric and ongoing treatment and medication costs are not covered.* Nurse on duty mornings, noon and evening. She makes referrals to Medical Clinic, headed by Dr. Julian Dresner, on campus. Medical questionnaire must be filled out in full, including allergies, allergic reactions to medications, and blood type.

**VACATION PERIODS:** No sheurim between 11 Tishrei/October 14 through 29 Tishrei/Nov. 1. The dorm and dining room will, however, reopen as of Erev Shmini Atzeret, October 24. Shmini Atzeret/Simchat Torah are spent at the Yeshiva. During Nissan the Yeshiva will be closed from Rosh Chodesh Nissan/March 30 through 28 Nissan/April 26. (The dorm and food services will be available during vacation periods if security measures are in force.)

**FIELD TRIPS** (*TIYULIM*): Every student will be eligible to participate in at least two major field trips. There will, of course, be Shabbatonim and all day *tiyulim* about once a month and major *tiyulim* conducted during vacation peroids.

**BEDDING (OPTIONAL):** A bedding set, including a warm winter quilt, a summer blanket, a pillow, a quilt cover, 5 sheets, 3 pillow cases, 1 bath towel and 1 hand towel can be purchased in Israel for fee of \$250 (US). Please indicate on CONFIRMATION if we are to prepare the set for you and add \$250 to first payment. This set is not returnable and bedding fee is not refundable.

VISITS: Students are not to leave Israel for any reason without consent of the Mashgiach, after request by parents has been approved. We request that trips taken in the middle of the zman be only in situations of absolute necessity. Parental visits are welcome. Student is to receive permission from Mashgiach for absences during parents' visit. Absence is to be limited to one 24-hour period (besides Shabbat).

**SAFE DEPOSIT BOX:** Keys to dorm room and safe deposit box (for valuables) will be given upon receipt of a \$20 cash deposit in Israel, to be refunded upon return of keys.
