The mitzvah of writing a Sefer Torah is the last mitzvah of the 613 mitzvoth, as written: "And now write this song".

The authorities debate if this mitzvah can be fulfilled via a partnership. However, the Pitchei Teshuva (Yoreh Deah, Siman 274) has testified "the established practice is to fulfill this mitzvah with groups of people participating; each individual fulfills his obligation".

A custom of the Jewish People qualifies as halacha. Perhaps a hint towards this minhag lies in the fact that the previous mitzvah is that of "hakhel". The entire nation unites- men, women and children- to attend the reading of the Torah from the king. We unite as one to accept the Torah as one person.

There is a special quality in writing a Sefer Torah as a partnership. The joint writing unites elders and youth, men, women and children. The Torah unites us for a sacred purpose, for a great mitzvah. We receive from, and give encouragement to each other in accepting the Rule of Hashem.

This concept receives additional significance in the form of a Sefer Torah written in honor of the jubilee year of Yeshivat Sha'alvim. The entire family of Yeshivat Sha'alvim joins together in a sacred endeavor intended to strengthen the yeshiva and its students.

Everyone is a partner; each according to his capabilities. This Sefer Torah expresses our partnership and it unites us in the building of Torahboth written and oral, in the Land of Israel and outside, for the individual and for the collectivity.

From the depths of my heart, I appreciate and bless all the participants in this holy endeavor. May Hashem fulfill the desires of your heart in both material and spiritual pursuits, and may you merit the fulfillment of the verse, "It is a tree of life for all who strengthen her".

מנהג ישראל תורה היא. שמא נוכל למצוא רמז למנהג בעבודה שהמצוה שקדמה לכתיבת ספר תורה היא מצוות הקהל. במצוות הקהל נאספים כל ישראל כאיש אחד אנשים נשים וטף. ושומעים את קריאת התורה ביחד כציבור, מפי מלך ישראל. זהו מעמד של קבלת תורה של כלל ישראל יחד כאיש אחד.

ואכן ישנה מעלה מיוחדת גם בדוקא בכתיבת ספר תורה שבו שותפים ולכתיבתו מתאחדים גדולים וקטנים, אנשים נשים וטף. כך התורה מאחדת אותנו כך נעשים כולנו שותפים, ואחים למשימה קדושה, ולמצוה גדולה. כולם מקבלים עול מלכות שמים זה מזה ונותנים רשות זה לזה.

את הדברים הללו ניתן לומר ביתר שאת בכתיבת ספר התורה הזה שנכתב לכבודה של ישיבת שעלבים לרגל יובל ה־50 להווסדה. כאן מתאחדים כל בני המשפחה, "משפחת שעלבים" למשימת קודש שנועדה גם לחזק את הישיבה ואת לומדיה.

The OT INSTITUTE is located in Jerusalem and its sofrim have written and recovered hundreds of Sifrei Torah. The Institute is led by Harav Yitzchack Goldstein '72 and Harav Yizchak Steiner, the sofrim who rescued 54 Torah scrolls from Iraq (while under the control of Saddam Hussein) by smuggling them in giant truck tires. Rav Yitzchack Goldstein is an ALUMNUS of Yeshivat Sharalvim, studied with the Rosh HaYeshiva Rav Yechezkel Yakobson while they were both students. 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### About Sha'alvim

The Yeshiva was founded in 1961, adjacent to Kibbutz Sha'alvim on a hill overlooking the Ayalon Valley, which was then just a few meters from the Jordanian border. The first group of 15 young students underwent military training and defended the region at night, while engaging in their studies during the day. Ultimately, they contributed to the unification of Jerusalem in 1967 and other major efforts to defend Israel.

As a dynamic, comprehensive educational center, Sha'alvim has over 2000 Students in branches ranging from a kindergarten to an advanced teacher's college. Sha'alvim's local institutions include: a regional elementary school; junior high school; high school; a Hesder program combining Judaic studies with military training and active service in the Israel Defense Forces; a research fellowship; the Moty Hornstein Institute for Overseas Students and the Sha'alvim Institute for Educational Leadership in the Diaspora. One of our newest programs is the highly acclaimed Sha'alvim For Women (SFW) which has educated hundreds of post-high school young women and helped them grow as B'not Torah.

Today, Sha'alvim is essentially an educational city located halfway between Jerusalem and Tel Aviv. It trains the next generation of Rabbis and Lay Leadership at an unparalleled level; it aims to battle assimilation by creating generations of Jewish leaders who care, not only for themselves, but for Jews everywhere, whether in Israel or throughout the world.

Over 100 faculty members and married students reside on the 15-acre campus with their respective families. Hundreds of alumni serve in educational and other communal capacities in Israel and in twenty other countries around the world. Our alumni, their parents and friends of the yeshiva are the direct partners of this success and fuel our efforts to be successful in our vital mission.
